- **3. Polonius** Lord Chamberlain, father of Laertes and Ophelia, helped Claudius take the throne
- **4. Horatio** scholar, friend of Hamlet, studied in Wittenberg with Hamlet.
- **5.** Laertes son of Polonius, brother of Ophelia, lives in France.
- **6. Voltimand** courtier, sent to Norway to persuade Fortinbras not to attack.
- 7. Cornelius courtier, sent to Norway to persuade Fortinbras not to attack.
- **8.** Rosencrantz friend of Hamlet, studied at Wittenberg, summoned by Claudius and Gertrude to learn why Hamlet is acting strangely.
- **9. Guildenstern** friend of Hamlet, studied at Wittenberg, summoned by Claudius and Gertrude to learn why Hamlet is acting strangely.
- **10. Osric** courtier, summons Hamlet to duel Laertes.
- 11. A gentleman noble in
- **12.** A priest presides over Ophelia's funeral
- **13.** Marcellus Danish officer on guard at Elsinore.
- **14. Bernardo** Danish officer on guard at Elsinore.
- **15. Francisco** soldier, guardsman at Elsinore.
- **16. Reynaldo** Polonius's servant, sent to France to spy on Laertes.
- 17. Players actors who come to visit Elsinore, Hamlet requests a play of them.
- **18.** Two clowns gravediggers, they dig Ophelia's grave.
- **19.** A captain Norwegian captain, works with Fortinbras
- 20. English Ambassadors
- **21. Fortinbras** Prince of Norway, son of Fortinbras Sr., wants to avenge his father's honour.
- **22. Gertrude** Queen of Denmark, widow of Hamlet Sr., wife of Claudius.
- 23. Ophelia daughter of Polonius, sister of Laertes, love interest of Hamlet.
- 24. Lords, Ladies, Officers, Soldiers, Players, Sailors, Messengers, and other Attendants the background characters within the play that flesh out the cast.
- **25. Ghost of Hamlet's father** father of Hamlet, deceased husband of Gertrude, brother of Claudius, murdered.

Setting

The play, *Hamlet*, is set in Elsinore, a city, in Denmark. It is set mostly in and around the palace there. The story takes place well before Shakespeare's time.

- queen of Denmark
- Hamlet's mum
- wife of Ghost & Claudius



Claudius

- king of Denmark
- Hamlet's uncle/step-dad
- killed Ghost



Polonius

- king's counsellor
- long-winded
- interfering



Laertes

- Polonius' son
- protective brother
- slightly hot-headed



Ophelia

- Polonius' daughter
- Hamlet's girlfriend
- horticulturalist



Horatio

- Hamlet's best friend
- mostly hangs around and listens to people



Reynaldo

- Polonius' servant
- sent to spy on Laertes while he's at school





Rosencrantz & Guildenstern

- Hamlet's friends, sent to spy on him
- nobody can tell them apart
- famous for being dead



Osric

- chatty courtier
- keeps putting hat on and taking it off again







Francisco, Barnardo & Marcellus

- sentries of Elsinore Castle
- spend all their time patrolling haunted battlements
- tell Hamlet about the Ghost that looks just like his dad





Voltemand & Cornelius

- Danish ambassadors to the King of Norway
- totally forgettable





Gravediggers

- real names unknown
- provide morbid comic relief (some of it funny)



Sailor

 gives Horatio a letter from Hamlet



Priest

 buries Ophelia, but refuses to do anything fancy for her



Fortinbras

- prince of Norway
- becomes king of Denmark at the end



Captain

- Fortinbras' captain
- Tells Hamlet Norway is invading Poland



Ambassador

- English ambassador
- Says "Rosencrantz and Guildenstern are dead."



Yorick

- ex-jester
- fellow of infinite jest
- now a skull







The Players

- group of travelling actors who stop by Elsinore for a gig
- perform "The Murder of Gonzago" aka "The Mousetrap"
- totally freak Claudius out by re-enacting Ghost's murder
